**TransForm Pharmaceuticals Ranks Second in *The Scientist* Magazine's
"Best Places to Work in Industry" Survey**

Lexington, MA—April 7, 2006— TransForm Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (TransForm) announced today that it has ranked second in "2006 Best Places to Work" survey conducted by *The Scientist* magazine. This marks the fourth consecutive year the company has made the list. TransForm ranked second in *The Scientist's* 2005 survey and sixth in its 2004 survey.

Respondents were asked to assess their working environment according to 44 criteria in eight different categories, including personal job satisfaction, job training and development, remuneration and benefits, and policies and practices. Employees at both large and small companies reported that the most important quality was the feeling of personal satisfaction in one's job at the end of the day.
